TASTING NOTES

Ruby in color, Bent Coast Pinot Noir is a smooth, fruit forward Pinot Noir with a richness and finesse.

AROMAS: Ripe berry, vanilla

FLAVORS: Blackberries, cherry, leather

FINISH: Velvety tannins, hint of spice

WINEMAKING

Alison Crowe, Winemaker

Grapes harvested at night, briefly cold soaked, and small vat fermented to max 85°F. Underwent 100% malolactic fermentation and racked in light and medium toast oak for 9 months.

VINEYARDS: Sandy, hilly, well-drained soil, certified sustainable

GRAPES: Non-GMO
