VARIETAL: Cabernet Sauvignon

TASTING NOTES

Big Six Cabernet Sauvignon is deep ruby in color, almost black due the unique method of making of this wine.

AROMAS: Dark fruit, caramel

FLAVORS: Plum, black currant, cassis, vanilla

FINISH: Chewy tannins, bourbon

WINEMAKING

Alison Crowe, Winemaker

100% de-stemmed then fermented in stainless steel tanks. Aged in 75% new French and American oak for the first year, then finished for three months in genuine Bourbon barrels, where they pick up a smooth, round and spiritous finish.
