Ruby in color, Bent Coast Pinot Noir is a smooth, fruit forward Pinot Noir with a richness and finesse.

**AROMAS:** Ripe berry, vanilla

**FLAVORS:** Blackberries, cherry, leather

**FINISH:** Velvety tannins, hint of spice

### WINEMAKING

Alison Crowe, Winemaker

Grapes harvested at night, briefly cold soaked, and small vat fermented to max 85°F. Underwent 100% malolactic fermentation and racked in light and medium toast oak for 9 months.
