TASTING NOTES

AROMAS: Pomegranate, hint of cassis

FLAVORS: Black cherries, dried cranberries, oak

FINISH: Silky, full texture

WINEMAKING

Alison Crowe, Winemaker

Fermented on the skins at 80°F up to two weeks for color and tannin extraction. Finished in new oak for several months.
