TASTING NOTES

Ripe berry and vanilla aromas followed by flavors of cherry, strawberry, cola, and a hint of spice.

AROMAS: Berry, vanilla

FLAVORS: Strawberry, cherry, cocoa, hint of spice

FINISH: Balanced, long finish

WINEMAKING

Individual vineyard blocks were fermented separately in stainless steel tanks. The lots were oak-aged with a mix of French, American and medium/medium+ toast levels.
